Exposure to Paint Terms & Conditions – Photography Workshops

1) Copyright & License: All photographs and paintings made by the participant (the client) during the workshop remain the intellectual property of the client. The client retains full copyright of this work. Clients' images may be used to promote future workshops but any requests by clients to not do so will be respected.

2) Payments: Payment in full is due upon booking to secure a place on workshop. Places can not be guaranteed without payment.

3) Refunds / Cancellation by the Client: a) Cancellations within 14 days of payment / booking will receive 100% refund. b) Cancellations more than 1 month before the workshop will receive a 50% refund. c) Cancellations within one month of the workshop will receive no refund.

4) Refunds / Cancellation by the Organisers due to insufficient numbers, weather or illness: Maximum possible notice will be given to the clients and a choice of a place on a future workshop, personal tuition to the equivalent value or a 100% refund will be offered in this circumstance.

5) Health & Safety: Care should be taken with regard to trip hazards and other general hazards. Paths in the garden at Gallery 36 can be slippery. No smoking is allowed at the venue.

6) Valuables: All valuable objects belonging to the client including camera equipment are the client's responsibility. No responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage of belongings within the venue or when left in vehicles.

7) Complaints: Any complaints regarding the workshop or the venue should be made in writing within seven days of the workshop. Any complaints will be taken extremely seriously and acted upon swiftly. Any feedback is also welcomed as it enables us to refine and improve what we offer.

8) Insurance: a) Anthony Cobley, trading as "Tony Cobley Photography" has professional public liability insurance up to £2.0M covering damages & costs arising out of the use of his photographic equipment. He also holds employer's liability insurance for £10.0M, covering assistants and sub-contract photographers. Professional Indemnity insurance is also held.

9) Governing Law: Any contract made between the organisers and the client shall in all respects be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law and the parties hereto submit to jurisdiction of the English courts.
